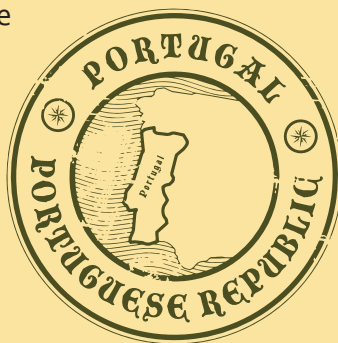

Itinerary

MONDAY, MAY 11TH –

Flight from Chicago O'Hare to Lisbon, Portugal

TUESDAY, MAY 12TH –

Arrival at Lisbon airport, meet and greet service by your local host and private transfer to your hotel in Sesimbra. Welcome dinner party at local seafood restaurant near our hotel. OVERNIGHT: SANA SESIMBRA HOTEL (or similar).

WEDNESDAY, MAY 13TH – SESIMBRA

Buffet breakfast. Free day for rest and relaxation in this lovely seaside resort town. OVERNIGHT: SANA SESIMBRA HOTEL (or similar).



THURSDAY, MAY 14TH – SESIMBRA • OBIDOS

Buffet Breakfast. Depart for Obidos, a fortified medieval village with narrow medieval streets and local artisans. Enjoy a village tour and a tasting of a local liquor, Ginginha. Remainder of the day free. OVERNIGHT: CASA DAS SENHORA RAINHAS (or similar).

FRIDAY, MAY 15TH – DAY TOUR FROM OBIDOS

Buffet Breakfast. Depart for Tomar that stretches along the banks of the Nabão at the foot of a wooded hill crowned by the Convent of Christ, where we'll enjoy a visit. Next head to Fatima one of the main points for Christ faith and pilgrimages in the world where we'll visit the sanctuary. In the afternoon visit Nazare, picturesque fishing village with the most typical and colored beach in Portugal. After we'll continue towards Alcobaca to visit the church Santa Maria, a World Heritage site, that features a great masterpiece of the Gothic sculpture: The Inês de Castro's tomb. Return to the hotel in Óbidos. OVERNIGHT: CASA DAS SENHORA RAINHAS (or similar).

SATURDAY, MAY 16TH – DAY TOUR FROM OBIDOS

Buffet breakfast. Depart to Coimbra where we will discover the city on foot, viewing one of the oldest universities in Europe and monuments such as the old cathedral, Sé Velha. We will visit the Holy Cross Monastery built in the XVI century over the remains of a monuments built in the XII century. On the way back to Óbidos stop in Batalha the location of the most important gothic monastery of Portugal, Santa Maria da Vitória. Return to the hotel in Óbidos. OVERNIGHT: CASA DAS SENHORA RAINHAS (or similar).

Pena Palace

SUNDAY, MAY 17TH – OBIDOS • SINTRA

Buffet breakfast. Morning departure to the charming hilltop village of Sintra. Upon arrival we'll pass by the old village while heading up the hill to the Pena National Palace, the most visited attraction in Portugal – considered by many as the most beautiful castle of Europe. Remainder of the day free. OVERNIGHT: SINTRA TIVOLI (or similar).

MONDAY, MAY 18TH – SINTRA • LISBON

Buffet breakfast. We'll say farewell to Sintra as we depart for our final destination, Lisbon. On the way we'll pass through Cascais and Estoril for a sightseeing. Upon arrival in Lisbon we'll visit the city center and Alfama – the oldest district of the capital, an old Moorish quarter with narrow streets and winding stairs. Remainder of the day free. OVERNIGHT: HOTEL FENIX LISBON (or similar).



TUESDAY, MAY 19TH – LISBON

Buffet breakfast. This morning we'll get to know the old and monumental Lisbon that was the capital of the world in the 15th Century. At the riverside suburb of Belem, we'll visit the church of the Hieronymus Monastery, the jewel of Manueline art, and the Belem Tower, built between 1515 and 1519 to defend the river mouth and the Hieronymus Monastery. Enjoy a "Pastel de Belém" pastry a typical Portuguese delight. Remainder of the day free. In the evening you will be picked up at your hotel for a farewell dinner at one of Lisbon's Portuguese Fado Houses. You will enjoy dinner and typical songs that create the feeling that the Portuguese people call "saudade".
